



















## **PRESUMPTION: BLUE WATER NAVY**

What: On January 1, 2020, the Blue Water Navy Act of 2019 went into effect Extends presumption of herbicide exposure, such as Agent Orange to BWN Veterans who developed one of 14 conditions which is presumed related to their exposure.

### Importance:

420,000 to 560,000 Vietnam-era Veterans may be considered Blue Water Navy Veterans


















## **VETERANS SUICIDE PREVENTION COMMITTEE**
